



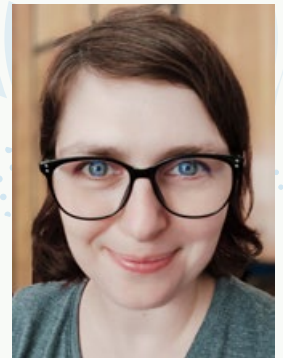

The period of communist rule in Poland was characterized by rigid centralized management of both cultural and history policy. One manifestation of this phenomenon was strict control of historical content that Polish research and cultural institutions could convey to the public. Among the victims of this policy was knowledge about the history of Polish Jews and of the Holocaust.

However, several institutions managed to resist this pressure and preserve and transmit the memory of Polish Jewry, including museums in Tykocin and Włodawa. We will examine the circumstances in which these museums were established, what challenges they faced, and how the Jewish history and culture of Poland was presented by these institutions.
